Dear Friends,

How do we remember a loved one, especially as we attend services during the High Holy Days and throughout the year? The answer is deeply personal, as there are many ways we commemorate, both privately and publicly.

Many Sinai Temple congregants find it meaningful to include a loved one's name in the annual High Holy Day *Book of Remembrance*, which is distributed, along with prayer books, throughout Sinai Temple each year. Another means of memory is to see the name(s) of our loved ones, as we recite the *Yizkor* prayers on Yom Kippur.

Many of our congregants find it meaningful to invest in a **permanent memorial wall plaque**, in memory of loved ones. These plaques are located on the *Memorial Wall* in the Ziegler Sanctuary. There, the names of loved ones are illuminated on days when *Yizkor* is recited, as well as on *yahrzeit* anniversary dates in perpetuity. Names that are inscribed on these plaques are automatically listed in a special, *Perpetual Memory* section of the annual *Book of Remembrance*. For those who have invested plaques, this inclusion is also in perpetuity.

To include a loved one's name in the **5779 Book of Remembrance**, please enter the information requested on the reverse side of this letter and return the form, along with a check (payable to Sinai Temple) in the amount of **\$18 per each individual** you wish to recognize, by **Friday, July 20, 2018**. An envelope is enclosed for your convenience.
