Regarding Zelophehad's daughters' claim to their father's land:

The women first challenge an unfair system but then immediately propose a solution. Their choice of words is astute. They use the language of loyalty to family, making a claim on behalf of their dead father. By emphasizing the desire to perpetuate their father's name, they speak to a timely communal and familial concern in an era of transition.... As some rabbinic sages note, the women make clear their desire to remain connected to community and family. This statement adds moral force to their request.

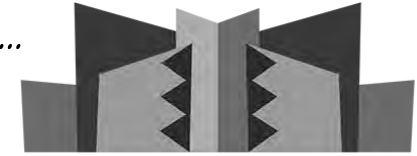
