SOURCES FOR STUDY

Loving kindness (chesed) is a central characteristic of the Jewish tradition. First and foremost, this mitzvah is owed and given to the living. The inherent dignity of every human being is grounded in the fact that he/ she is created in the image of God. As the Talmud instructs us (Sanhedrin 37A): The image of God is born with three fundamental dignities: 1) infinite value - this is why if you save one life, it is equivalent to saving a whole world; 2) equality – every human is a legitimate image of the divine but no one type is a preferred representation. The claim that there is a superior image of God is a form of idolatry. The denial of the equal dignity of another human being constitutes the denial of their being an image of God.

The final fundamental dignity is: 3) uniqueness - each human is one of a kind; there will never be another person just like this one. The denial of another's uniqueness - by stereotyping and anonymous degradation -constitutes disrespect and denial of the Other as a precious image of God.
