A MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT MEHRZAD ROSHAN

How am I supposed to make decisions without you?

Do you remember our last decision in the safe room?

'Do we fight or surrender?' You said, 'Fight.'

These are the last spoken words between Yarden and Shiri Bibas on October 7, 2023, before they were taken hostage along with their two children, Ariel and Kfir.

Our hearts are wrenched with pain and grief as Shiri, Ariel, and Kfir were laid to rest. There are no words to fully capture the depth of this sorrow.

As we mourn, we also reaffirm our commitment to stand together, to fight for Israel, and to uphold the legacy and the names of those we have lost.

As we approach Purim, we are reminded that our story is one of resilience and survival. The story of Purim is not just about triumph but about the courage to stand up in the face of destruction. Queen Esther did not remain silent-she acted. She risked everything to save her people. Like Esther, we, too, must have the courage to speak up, act, and ensure Am Israel's survival.

Yes, we will fight, as Jews have done for thousands of years. We are here; we endure. And we will continue to fight not just for Israel's survival but for its strength, its future, and its peace.
